What is Hospice?

Hospice is a way of caring for & supporting a person diagnosed with a terminal illness. Hospice care focuses on providing comfort & pain management, rather than providing a curative treatment. Who is Eligible for Hospice Care?

Hospice can be provided to anyone, regardless of age, who has been diagnosed with a terminal illness & has been given 6 months or less to live (if the illness runs its normal course). Who Pays for Hospice?

There are different ways in which your hospice care is paid for – Medicare, Medical Assistance, MinnesotaCare & private insurance policies. We will work with you, your family & your insurance company to determine the payer source for your care. Included in your covered hospice benefit are the following:

- A Divine Hospice Registered Nurse (RN) on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Prescription drugs related to your terminal illness to provide pain relief & symptom management
- Services of all hospice team members
- Short-term inpatient care (if necessary)
- Medical equipment & supplies
- Short-term respite care
- Therapy Programs: Physical, Occupational, Speech, Massage, Pet & Aromatherapy
- Volunteer services

Again, all of these services provided to you must be related to your terminal illness for them to be covered.
